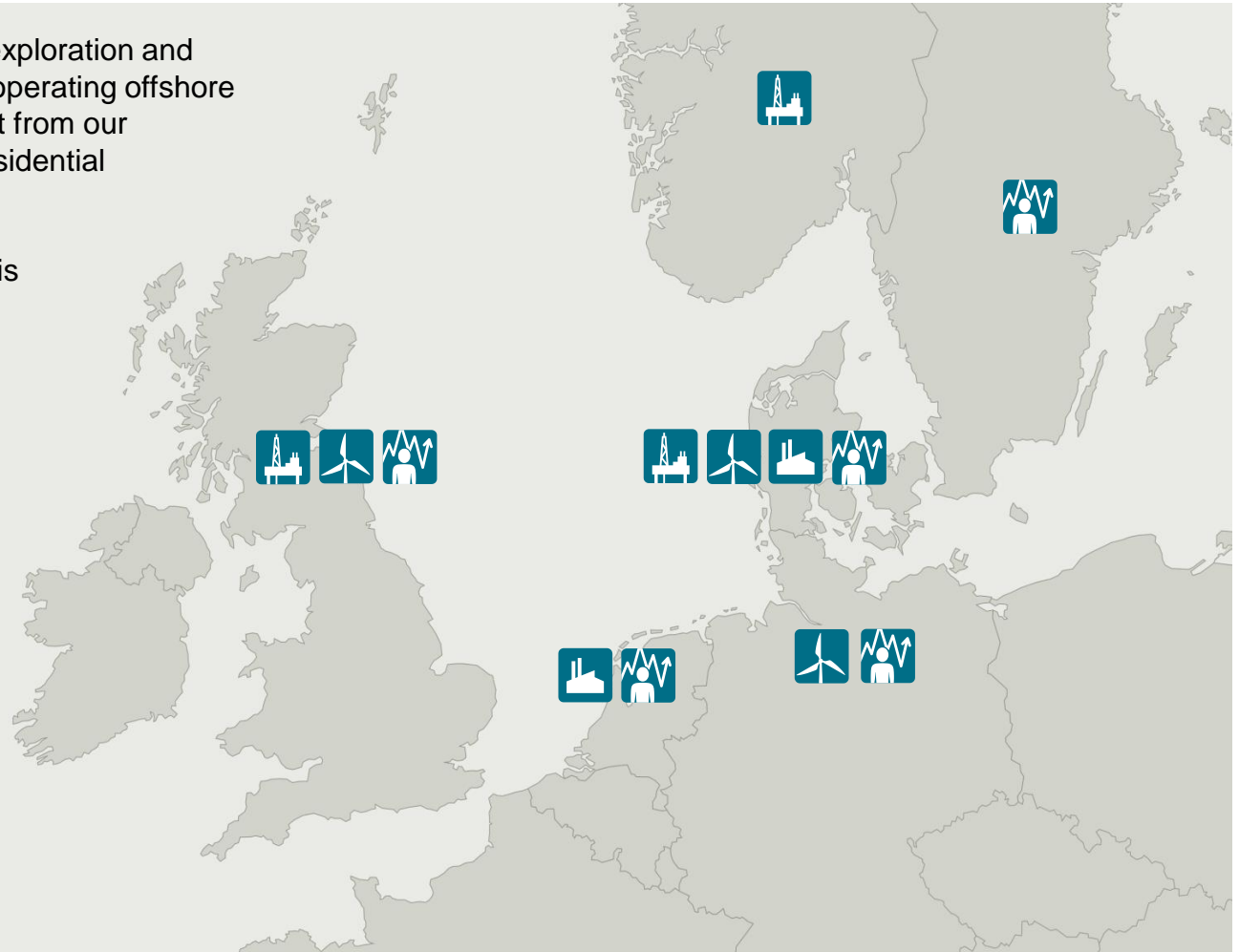

# DONG Energy is one of the leading energy groups in Northern Europe

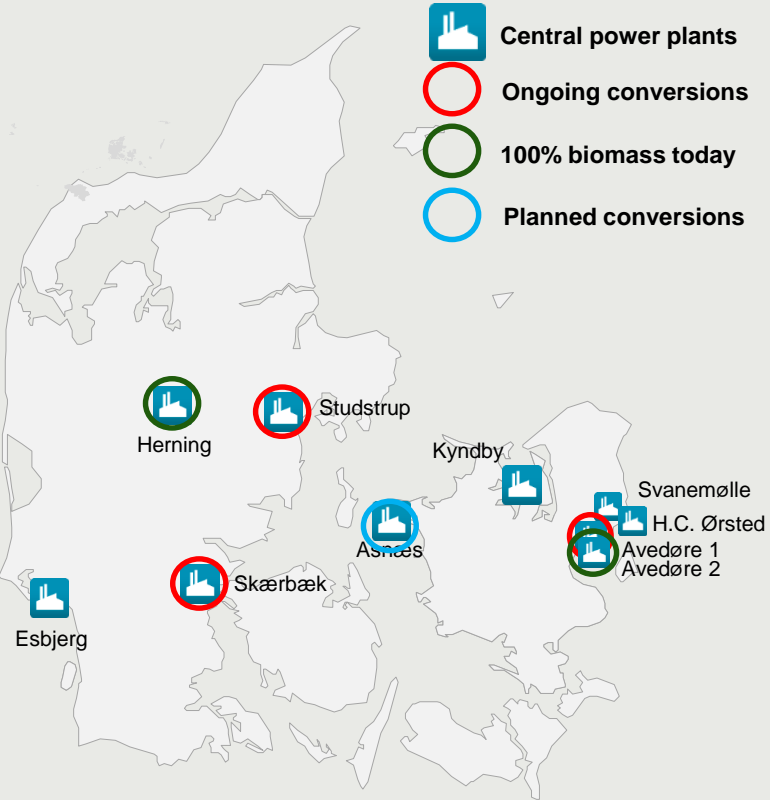

DONG Energy has 6,500 employees and is headquartered in Denmark.

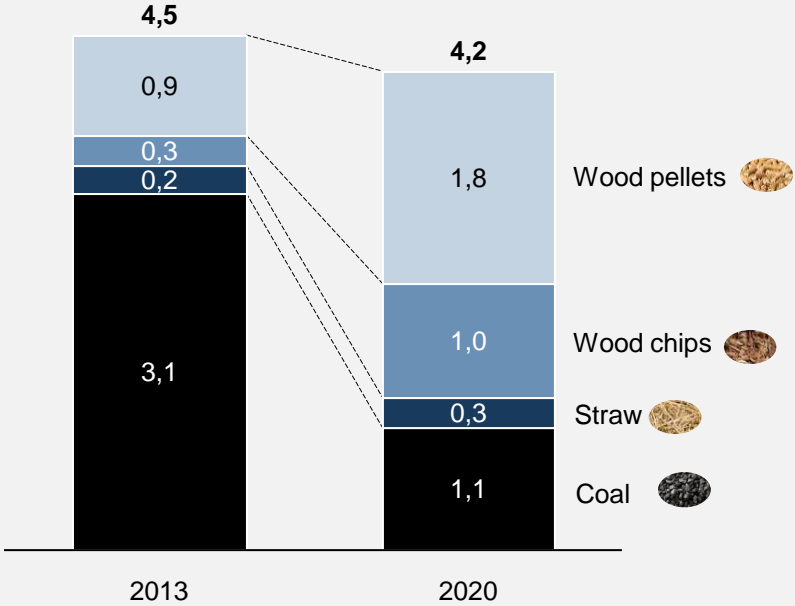

▪ After conversions DONG Energy expects to reduce coal consumption by approx. 65%

# DONG Energy Programme for Sustainable Biomass Sourcing communicates how we will ensure sustainability and reach our targets

## We must ensure:

- Alignment with Danish Industry Agreement for Sustainable Biomass
- Compliance through SBP or FSC certification

## DONG Energy only buy biomass where the following is ensured:

1. Replanting
2. Protection of ecosystems and biodiversity
3. Protection of areas of high conservation value
4. Enforcement of Health and Safety, Social and Human Rights
5. Compliance with DONG Energy code of conduct



# Danish Industry Agreement on Sustainable Biomass defines sustainability for biomass and GHG targets used in the Danish energy sector



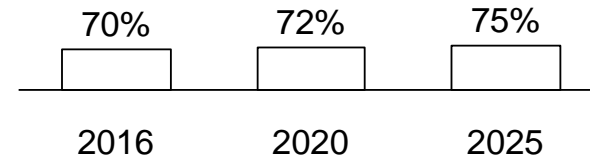
- Agreement between Danish Energy Association and Danish District Heating Association entered into December 2014
- Voluntary - not regulation
- Based on SBP
- Set targets on:
  1. Green house gas emission reductions compared to coal
  2. Speed of implementation

### Green House Gas (GHG) supply chain emissions



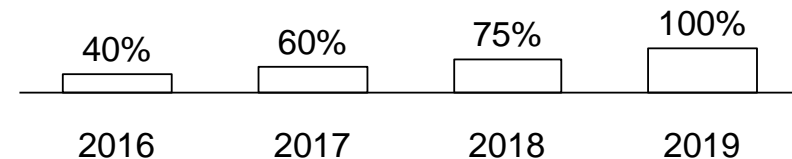
Reduction compared to coal\*
